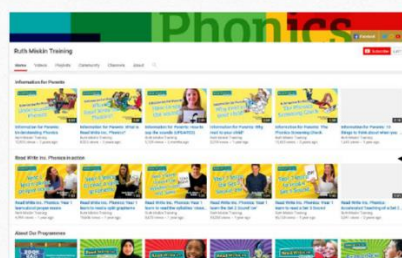

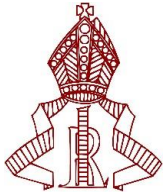


Ruth Miskin has range of very useful videos on 'YouTube' that can be accessed for free and will help with understanding the process and of course how to say the 'pure' sounds.
