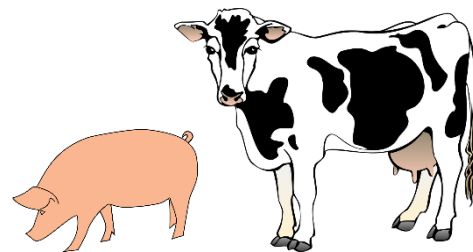
Dear Rumboldswyke families,

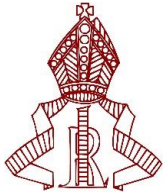
