### A Friendly Reminder: Park & Stride for Safer School Mornings!

We'd like to kindly remind everyone about the importance of parking responsibly around Rumbolds Close, particularly during school drop-off and pick-up times.

Rumbolds Close can get very congested, making it challenging for pedestrians and cyclists to safely

navigate. To ensure the safety and well-being of all, we strongly encourage you to consider using the *Park & Stride* method.



Here's how it works:

- **Park a little further away** from the school — in nearby streets or designated parking areas.
- Stride the rest of the way enjoy a short walk with your child, making the school run a fun and active part of your day!

Not only will this reduce traffic congestion around Rumbolds Close, but it will also help improve air quality, reduce the risk of accidents, and encourage healthy habits for both parents and children.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. Together, we can make school mornings and afternoons safer and more pleasant for everyone!
