
What another beautiful week of sunshine!!

# East Services at St George's

All are very welcome to attend the services at St George's during Holy Week and Easter, including those on Maundy Thursday (with foot-washing and silent prayer until midnight), Good Friday, the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday. For families and children, there will be a special service of Stations of the Cross on Good Friday at 10am, which also includes building an Easter garden together and eating hot cross buns.

Like last year, for the Easter Vigil, one of the most beautiful services of the year, full of mystery and symbolism, children and families will be invited to be fully involved in the service, starting with lighting a fire outside the church, processing the Easter candle, blessing the Font, and leading into joyful proclamation of Jesus' resurrection and the first Eucharist of Easter.

After the service, there will be a barbeque with activities and a film for the children and a sleepover for older children. Then on Easter Sunday, as we celebrate the joy of Christ's resurrection, there will be an Easter Egg hunt and activities for children.
